Senior Project Associate (one post)

2. MD in Microbiology, Medicine, Pulmonary Medicine, or equivalent; or

3. PhD in any clinical or microbiological discipline.

Desirable: At least one original research publication as lead author in an indexed peer-reviewed

scientific journal, or experience of handling research projects in a supervisory role.

Age limit: Below 40 years.

Emoluments: As per project guidelines (currently Rs. 42,000 + 16% HRA per month).

Nature of duty: Overall scheduling and management of study-defined activities as per the research

protocol; coordinating and implementing all laboratory activities; coordinating and monitoring patient recruitment, patient consent, and collection/transport/storage of clinical samples; completing case record forms as per project SOPs; coordinating project biobank activities; quality assurance; maintaining inventory of equipment and consumables; training and supervision of other project staff; periodic appraisal and analysis of project data; writing of scientific reports and research papers; and liaison with various central data management and site coordination committees.
